



# Terms & Conditions

## Nesu Produced Limited

These Terms & Conditions govern the engagement of services provided by **Nesu Produced Limited** (“the Company”, “we”, “our”, or “us”). By engaging Nesu Produced Limited, the client (“the Client”) agrees to the following terms.

---

## 1. Scope of Services

Nesu Produced Limited provides consulting, planning, coordination, and delivery services for events including corporate functions, conferences, activations, private events, and related experiences.

Services may include but are not limited to:

- Event consulting and advisory
- Event planning and coordination
- Supplier and vendor coordination
- Production management
- On-site event management
- Project management and event logistics

The specific scope of services will be defined in written communication, proposal, or invoice issued by Nesu Produced Limited.

## 2. Engagement and Acceptance

An engagement with Nesu Produced Limited is considered confirmed when:

- A proposal or agreement is accepted, or
- An invoice or deposit is paid, or
- Written confirmation to proceed is provided by the Client.

Once engagement is confirmed, planning and coordination services may commence.

---

## 3. Fees and Payment Terms

All service fees will be outlined in proposals, quotations, or invoices issued by **Nesu Produced Limited**.

Unless otherwise agreed in writing:

- Invoices are payable within **7 days of issue**
- Deposits may be required to secure event dates
- Late payments may result in suspension of services

Nesu Produced Limited reserves the right to charge reasonable recovery costs for overdue accounts.

---

## 4. Project Management and Coordination

Nesu Produced Limited may act as the coordinating party between the Client and event suppliers. This includes managing communication, scheduling, and logistics.

While reasonable care and professional oversight are provided, **Nesu Produced Limited does not assume responsibility for the operational performance of third-party suppliers.**

---

## 5. Third-Party Suppliers

Events may involve engagement with external suppliers including:

- Venues
- Production and technical providers
- Catering services
- Equipment suppliers
- Furniture and exhibition contractors
- Entertainment providers

Where suppliers are engaged:

- Contracts may exist directly between the Client and the supplier
- Nesu Produced Limited is not liable for supplier performance, delivery failures, or contractual disputes

Supplier costs will be communicated prior to confirmation wherever possible.

---

## 6. Client Responsibilities

The Client agrees to:

- Provide accurate and timely information required for planning
- Approve decisions and deliverables within agreed timelines
- Ensure appropriate permissions, licences, and venue approvals are obtained where required
- Provide timely payment of agreed fees

Delays in approvals or information may impact event delivery timelines.

---

## 7. Changes to Scope

Events are dynamic in nature. If the Client requests changes to scope including:

- Increased event scale
- Additional services
- Timeline changes
- Additional coordination

Nesu Produced Limited reserves the right to revise service fees accordingly.

Any significant scope changes will be communicated before additional work proceeds.

---

## 8. Event Cancellations or Postponements

If an event is cancelled or postponed after services have commenced:

- The Client remains responsible for payment of work completed to date
- Any non-recoverable supplier costs remain the responsibility of the Client

Nesu Produced Limited will make reasonable efforts to minimise cancellation costs where possible.

---

## 9. Limitation of Liability

Nesu Produced Limited will exercise reasonable care and professional skill in providing services.

However, the Company shall not be liable for losses resulting from:

- Supplier failures or delays
- Venue restrictions or operational limitations
- Weather conditions
- Transportation disruptions
- Public safety issues
- Government restrictions
- Any circumstance beyond reasonable control

To the fullest extent permitted by law, liability is limited to the value of services provided by Nesu Produced Limited.

---

## 10. Force Majeure

Nesu Produced Limited shall not be held liable for failure or delay in performing services due to events outside reasonable control including but not limited to:

- Natural disasters
  - Government restrictions
  - Public health emergencies
  - Venue closures
  - Transportation disruption
  - Civil unrest
- 

## 11. Intellectual Property

All concepts, planning materials, event documentation, and creative materials produced by Nesu Produced Limited remain the intellectual property of the Company unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Such materials may not be reproduced or distributed without permission.

## 12. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding any commercial, financial, or operational information shared during the course of engagement.

---

## 13. Website Use

Information contained on the Nesu Produced Limited website is provided for general information purposes. While care is taken to ensure accuracy, no guarantees are provided regarding completeness or suitability for specific purposes.

## 14. Amendments
